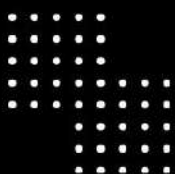

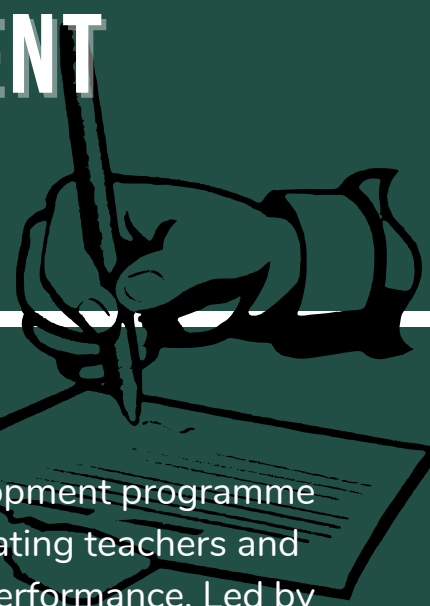
DAILY ASSEMBLY



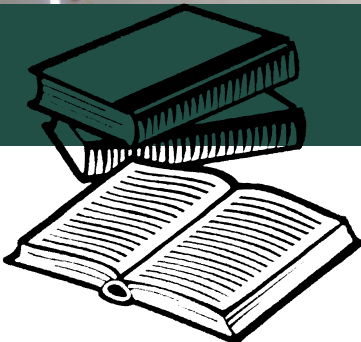

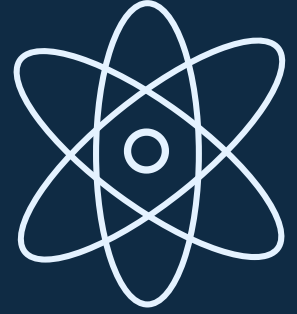

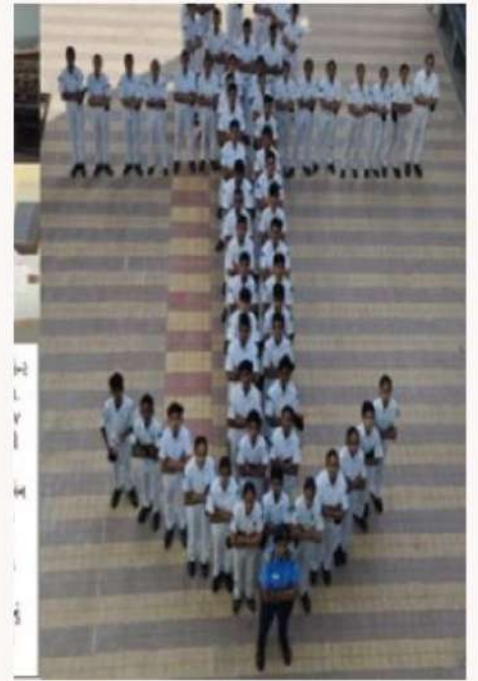
The event was graced by the presence of Commanding Officer Lieutenant Commander Indrajeet Singh Chauhan, who served as the chief guest for the occasion.

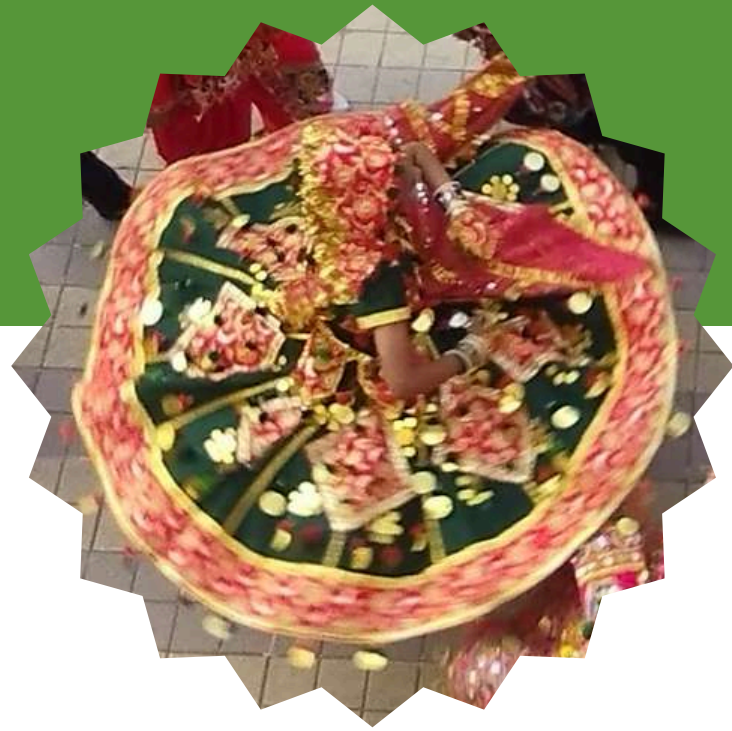
REVERBERATING NAVRATRI FESTIVITIES

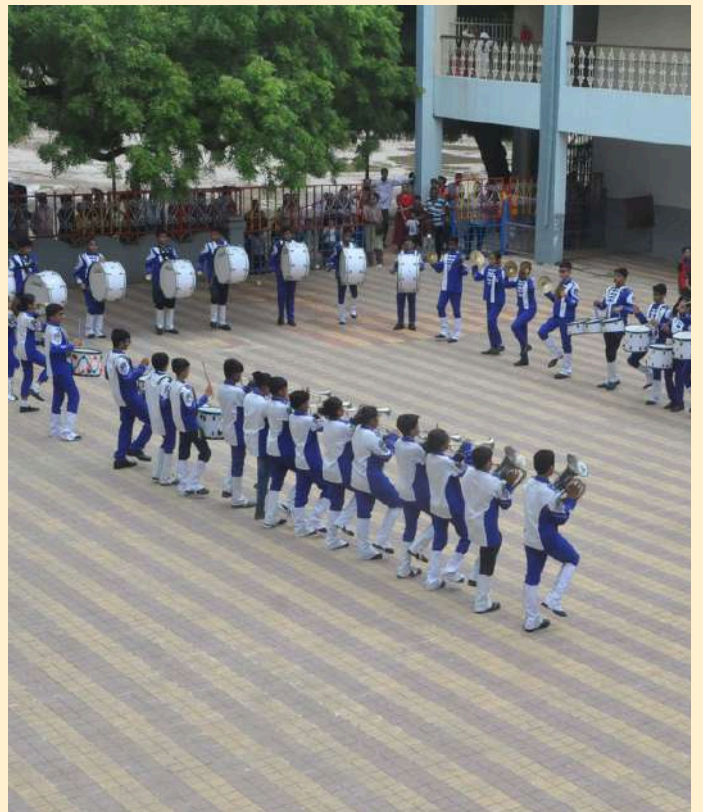
